


Year 3 Newsletter Term 2

Things to remember...

Reading- We are promoting a love of reading across the Academy and would appreciate your support with this, ensuring that you and your child are reading widely and regularly; exposure to a range of different text types will really boost their confidence.

In line with guidance previously sent out, please keep books at home until completed and instead of using a paper reading journal, please send a message on Class dojo each time you read with your child so we can build a digital journal. **English:** During this term, Y3 will be working with a range of themed texts including How to wash a woolly mammoth by Michelle Robinson and Kate Hindley, The Dark by Lemony Snickett, The light house keepers Lunch by David and Ronda Armitage.

Maths: This term we will be exploring the four operations. By the end of term, children will be able to:

- Use mental strategies to add and subtract
- Use written methods for addition and subtraction
- Recall multiplication facts for 2,4,5,8,10 times tables
- Solve problems involving addition and subtraction
