We will continue to have spelling tests every Friday with weekly spellings posted on Teams.

<u>Maths</u>

We shall be revisiting measures including finding the perimeter of a shape and then our emphasis will be on multiplication and division with regular revision of past learning. It is a national expectation that all children can rapidly recall all the multiplication and divisiob facts from the times tables up to 12 x 12 by the end of Year 4. Science

Our focus is on sound this term.

We shall be studying Islam and Muslim views and beliefs about Community.



History
