

THE ACADEMY COMMITMENT

The academy will do its best to:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection;
- Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can;
- Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19;
- Inform you of a confirmed case of COVID-19 and follow all current advice on whether to partially close, close or remain open.
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to promoting and rewarding positive behaviours in line with our Behaviour Policy. If children cannot stick to the rules during this period we will contact you as they may need to go home and not return until they can be safe.
- Communicate between home and school through text, email and calls and use the school website and Twitter.
- We are committed to be paperless throughout this period, this means we will not send paper copies home, and we cannot accept paper from you.
- Provide an education that supports children's needs on their return from lockdown.

PARENT/CARER COMMITMENT

To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will engage with the NHS test and trace process and book a test. I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone including the results of a test.
- If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, the academy will inform me and I will collect my child from school immediately;
- When dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to social distancing rules and follow all markings on site.
- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child;
- I will need to remind my child about social distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child may not always do this successfully
- My child will need to use good respiratory and hand hygiene;
- I will not be allowed into the academy site. I will make contact via telephone or email the office.
- I need to work with all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this time;
- Read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home to keep updated;
- I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details.
- If my child does not follow the guidelines, he/she may be sent home and may not return to school until they can be safe.

CHILD COMMITMENT

I will do my best to:

- Stick to the social distancing rules in class and in the playground;
- Tell an adult if I feel unwell;
- Not bring additional things into school from home, or take things home from school;
- Only use the equipment provided to me by school and no other;
- When I am in school, only mix with children in my 'bubble'.
- Only enter and exit the school building using the directed doorways.
- Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (catch it-bin it-kill it);
- Follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds/ hand sanitiser;
- Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others;
- Follow these expectations and know that if I don't, I will be sent home and may not be able to come back into school until I can be safe.

- We are asking the children to wash hands regularly with hand washing demonstrations to ensure children are taking the necessary precautions.
- We have hand sanitisers all around school for children to access at all times.
- Children will be reminded to cough and sneeze into their elbow or a tissue and that any tissues must be binned straight away.
- Social distancing will be in place where possible to ensure no mixing of bubbles on site.
- Movements through the corridor will be strictly monitored and reduced to toilet trips only for children.
- Clean clothes are important. Your child may need clean clothes throughout the week if they become dirty.
- The outdoor environment will be very important during the Autumn term.

We are working hard to keep your child safe throughout this period of reopening to all children and to ensure there is minimal contact with other children and adults in school.

We need you to ensure this continues when your child is not in school and on their journey to and from the academy. Many thanks for your support in this.
