



## Maths at Skegness Junior Academy



Our aim at Skegness Junior Academy is for children to understand mathematical concepts and use the skills learned to solve practical, real life problems. Our maths curriculum has been developed in response to the children's needs and each term areas to be developed are identified and opportunities planned for. We encourage children to reflect on what they have learnt and how this can be applied in the future. We provide enjoyable and exciting maths opportunities to motivate children and support their understanding through engaging games and technology. Maths is a vital life skill and doesn't just happen in maths lessons. Elements of the maths curriculum are taught through other subject areas and children utilise their maths skills in all curriculum areas.

Arithmetic - In Key Stage Two children do 'Maths Blast' sessions throughout the week. This is an opportunity for children to practise their arithmetic skills within a given time. Also every child has a log on for TimesTable RockStars and are given regular opportunities to try to beat their score each week. These Log on details are also available for children to use at home.
