Science

English

Then we will later move onto writing a newspaper report on the famous suffragettes.

Curriculum

In music we will be looking at composition, percussion and musical notes to in the process of creating out very own musical masterpieces.

In PE we will be learning the skills for gymnastics and swimming so the children can achieve our academy motto of 'happy, healthy hearts pumping'.
