## Welcome to Skegness Junior Academy

Welcome to term 5! This term we will be exploring the blue planet and specifically looking at habitats.

#### Maths

This term we will be learning all about money, and shape as well as continuing to consolidate our learning about addition, subtraction and problem solving.

We'll learn about different coins, and how to find change. About 2D and 3D shapes as well as collecting data, presenting it in graphs and charts and interpreting it.



As always we will continue to develop our rapid recall of the 3,4 and 8 times tables. Practising at home using TT Rockstars is a really fun and great way to help develop this and challenge yourself to increase your speed. Aim for less than 5 seconds per question!

### **English**

In English this term will be using Sandra Diekmann's wonderful story of LEAF to inspire our own first person narratives, before asking the question Can we Save the Tiger? in some emotional persuasive letters.

We'll be developing our use of descriptive language and trying our best to choose language for the greatest effect upon the reader. We will be focusing on punctuation and learning how make our writing more exciting to read!

### <u>Science</u>

In Science this term, we will be learning about the fascinating world of plants and be exploring their purpose alongside their requirements to live and grow. We will also be planning our own investigation to discover the impact that different amounts of water and light have on this.

## <u>Curriculum</u>

In Geography, we will be learning about who lives in Antarctica, using our geography skills

In PSHE we'll be learning about Living in the Wider World, which incorporates living within boundaries and following rules to be a good citizen.

RE will see us learning about what 'Goodness' means to different groups of people and different faith groups.

PE days will remain the same. This term we will be learning multiskills and athletics in preparation for Sport Day in Term 6. After school Summer Sports Club will continue on Tuesday afternoons and Dance Club will remain on a Thursday afternoon.
