<u>Science</u>

In science this term, we will be looking at animals and humans. As part of this unit, we will be exploring the different teeth we have and their purposes. We will also be looking at our digestive system, the organs we have and what they do for our bodies. We will of course still be completing lots of exciting experiments throughout the unit.

As you will be aware we are now using Boom reader to log children's reading. Thank you to everyone that has engaged with this, hopefully you find it very quick and straightforward to use. Reading at home is so important in your child's reading progress journey and we do ask that you try to read with your child at least 4 times per week to continue developing this most important skill!
