



Year 3 - Term 6 2024 This is Me!

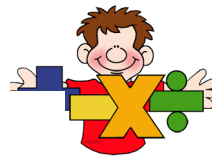


Welcome to Skegness Junior Academy

Welcome to Term 6! This term we will be exploring Skegness and the local area.

Maths

This term we will be revisiting all of the operations— addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will also be learning how to tell the time both digitally and on an analogue clock. This will incorporate reading calendars accurately and problem solving.



We will also be learning about fractions and will also be incorporating some practical maths along side this!

As always we will continue to develop our rapid recall of the 3x, 4x and 8x times tables. Practising at home using TT Rockstars is a really fun and great way to help develop this and challenge yourself to increase your speed. Aim for less than 5 seconds per question!

English

In English this term we will be learning how to debate and write a balanced argument, using the subject of whether zoos are good or bad and the reasons we make those decisions. We'll be developing our use of persuasive language and technical vocabulary, trying our best to choose language for the greatest effect upon the reader. We will be focusing on punctuation and learning how make our writing more exciting to read!

Science

In science this term, we will be learning about Animals including Humans. This will incorporate learning about healthy lifestyles, eating well and different food types. We will also be investigating the function of the skeleton and important muscles in the human body.

Key messages

As the weather gets better we will be using the field more at break times and for PE, please make sure that children are bringing water only in their class water bottle.

We will also be going out into our local community more to enhance our learning.

Curriculum

In Geography, we will be learning about local history. We will also be comparing landscapes in Europe with a place similar to Skegness.

In PSHE we'll be learning about Living in the Wider World, which incorporates living within boundaries and following rules to be a good citizen.

RE will continuing to learn about what 'Goodness' means to different groups of people and different faith groups.

PE days will remain the same. This term we will be preparing for Sport Day and learning to play tennis and rounders. After school Summer Sports Club will continue on Tuesday afternoons.
