## Welcome to Skegness Junior Academy

Welcome to term 3! This term we will be going above and beyond in our learning and Y3 will be focussing on Traditional Tales.

### Maths

This term we will be continuing our learning on addition and subtraction and begin looking at multiplication and division. We will be learning how to use the inverse to check our answers are correct.



We will continue to develop our rapid recall of the 3,4 and 8s. Practising at home using TT Rockstars is a really fun and great way to help develop this, so please encourage your child to play at home.

### English

English this term will be closely linked to our topic of Traditional Tales and we will be looking at the story of The Last Wolf which is based upon Little Red Riding Hood with a bit of a spin!

We'll be developing our use of descriptive language and trying our best to choose language for the greatest effect upon the reader. We will be focussing on punctuation and learning how make our writing more exciting to read!

### Science

In science this term, we will be learning about Forces and Magnets, particularly focussing on attraction and repulsion as well as north and south poles. We'll be developing our investigative skills to make predictions and plan our own investigations.

### Curriculum

In PSHE we'll be learning about dreams and goals and how we achieve anything we set our mind to. During this, we will also be considering any challenges that may arise and how to overcome them.

In History we will be learning about the Bronze Age and Iron Age and how their ways of life improved significantly from the Stone Age including farming, housing and weaponry.

In art we will be exploring the famous artist, Norman Foster and producing artwork inspired by some of his famous pieces.
