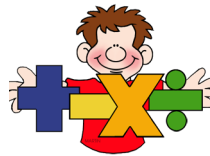

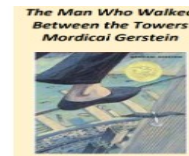
Maths

In Mathematics, children will continue to develop their number skills across the four operations, further building on both their mental and written methods. They will also deepen their reasoning skills and extend their mathematical vocabulary. A strong emphasis will remain on problem solving and SATs style questions to support preparation for the assessments in May. In addition, regular use of Times Tables Rock Stars (TTRS) at home is strongly encouraged to help reinforce these key skills.



English

- In English, we will be writing a recount in the role of a character inspired by 'The man who walked between the towers'. Also we will be writing our own extended narrative inspired by The Hobbit!



Science

In science we will be investigating Living things and their habitats. We will also be developing our learning by investigating statistics and presenting our data in a range of different mathematical ways.

Curriculum

Our World Apart theme continues throughout the wider curriculum. In addition to this theme, we will be building our French skills, listening to and performing a range of popular music. To inspire us further, we will be creating our own artwork based on the work of architect Norman Foster
