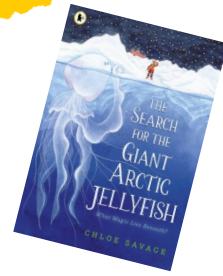




Year 3 - Term 6 2026 This is Me!

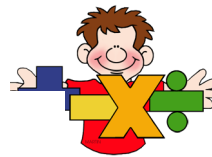


Welcome to Skegness Junior Academy- Term 6 newsletter

Welcome to Term 6 and the final term of the year. We aim to end the year with of a celebration of all that we have achieved. There will be lots of fun opportunities such as sports days and trips.

Maths

This term we will be revisiting all of the operations— addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will also be learning how to tell the time on an analogue clock. This will incorporate reading calendars accurately and problem solving.



We will continue to learn about 3D shapes as well as how we can use statistics to present and interpret data.

As always we will continue to develop our rapid recall of the 3x, 4x and 8x times tables. Practising at home using TT Rockstars is a really fun and great way to help develop this and challenge yourself to increase your speed. Aim for less than 5 seconds per question!

English

In English this term we will be studying 2 key texts, The search for the giant arctic Jellyfish and Leon and the place between.

We will be using prepositions as well as practicing using subordinating clauses to write diary entries as well as producing persuasive texts such as adverts and posters.

Our final reading book for the year will be Llama out Loud which promises to be an enjoyable and hilarious read!

Science

In science this term, we will be learning about Animals including Humans. This will incorporate learning about healthy lifestyles, eating well and different food types. We will also be investigating the function of the skeleton and important muscles in the human body.

Key messages

As the weather gets better we will be using the field more at break times and for PE, please make sure that children are bringing water only in their class water bottle.

We will also be going out into our local community more to enhance our learning.

Curriculum

In Geography, we will be learning about Antarctica and how this place contracts with our own in terms of land usage, formation and habitats.

In PSHE we'll be learning about how bodies change and how to look after them. Please speak to class teachers or to the RSE lead if you want to access or discuss the specific content we will be delivering. .

RE will continuing to learn about what 'Goodness' means to different groups of people and different faith groups.

PE days will remain the same. This term we will be preparing for Sport Day and learning to play tennis and rounders. After school Summer Sports Club will continue on Wednesday afternoons.
