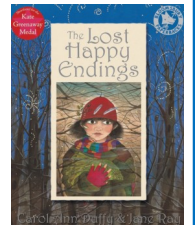
Maths

During this term, we will be working on measures, shape and geometry, whilst also continuing to practise and revise previously learnt skills so they stay fresh in our mind, ready for our final round of testing. To support with this at home, measuring food in the kitchen using both grams and kilograms would really support your child. Also, measuring volume in millilitres, centilitres and litres, converting between the three. Rapid recall of multiplication facts continues to be a high priority and we encourage pupils to increase their recall speed using the TT Rockstars program at home.



English

In English, we will be using the story, 'The Lost Happy Endings' as a stimulus to write a diary entry. We will be revisiting work on similes and relative clauses as part of our sentence level work.



In Reading lessons, we are studying, 'The Highland Falcon Thief' by MG Leonard. This is an exciting crime thriller, set aboard a royal train on its final journey, a 'who's dunnit?' that involves celebrities, royalty and two plucky children who solve a crime.



Science

In science we will be looking at life cycles of animals, including humans. We will be studying the human body and how we change throughout our lifetime.

We'll also be finding opportunities to use our wonderful nature area and pond to observe wildlife and document their different stages of life.

Reading at Home

Curriculum

In RE, we will be looking at why certain places are significant to believers, with a key focus on Jerusalem. Computing will focus on vector drawing. In Art, we will be continuing our work on fashion design and the works of Alexander McQueen. In history, we will be learning about the Norman Conquest in the 11th century and the impact it had on England.
