### Maths

During this term, Y4 will be revisiting multiplication, division and fractions alongside revising all of our Year 4 maths learning ahead of our final round of assessments in week two and three. Children will also be spending an increased amount of time on Times Table Rockstars in the initial part of this term, ahead of their official MTC check at the end of week two. Because of the importance of this, we will be encouraging all children to practise on the Soundcheck, single-player game mode at home as much as possible.



### English

During this term, Y4 will be exploring the emotional, persuasive advert, presented by Greenpeace and titled 'Rang-tan the story of dirty palm oil'

In this unit of work, children will develop their ability to write persuasively, before creating their own advert about a different contentious world issue.

In Whole Class Reading, we will be continuing to explore 'Land of Roar' which is all about a set of twins who differ in both maturity and mindset when it comes to exploring the fictional Land of Roar, which they both created when they were younger.



### Science

This term we will be exploring 'Living things and their characteristics'. Within this topic, children will be sorting animals into the different classification groups. We will also be looking at the acronym MRS GREN - (movement, respiration, sensitivity, growth, reproduction, excretion and nutrition).



### Reading at Home

We are continuing to promote a love of reading across the Academy and would appreciate your support with this, ensuring that you and your child are reading widely and regularly; exposure to a range of different text types will really boost their performance. We would like home reading to take place at least 3 times a week. Please record home reading in the new reading records.



### Our Curriculum

This term, will be learning all about how the Romans came to power after conquering England and taking it from the Celts. This topic will culminate in a visit to Lincoln castle for a Romans workshop.
